Samartha Trust, a non-profit organization established in April 2019 in Bangalore, is devoted to building an inclusive and equitable society for children facing challenging circumstances. Guided by a deep commitment to empowerment, the Trust strives to provide children with the support, resources, and opportunities they need to thrive.

At the core of our mission is the focus on children with disabilities and those from underprivileged communities. We actively rescue and enroll these children in schools while offering residential care for those in dire need. Beyond education, we operate community learning centers in the slums of Bangalore, creating safe spaces for learning and development.



Samartha Trust also runs sensitization programs to promote awareness and social inclusion, working to break down societal barriers and ensure every child and their community has a fair and equal chance at growth and success. Our holistic approach is grounded in the belief that every child, regardless of their circumstances, deserves the opportunity to realize their full potential.

KEY MILESTONES AND GROWTH

Since our inception, Samartha Trust has been unwavering in its mission to create a brighter future for children with disabilities and those from marginalized communities.

01 Our journey began with a focus on Inclusive Education for Children with Special Needs, ensuring that every child, regardless of their abilities, has access to education and the joy of learning.

02 2019 marked a pivotal year, with the establishment of our School Readiness Center for Children with Disabilities, which supported 30 children with tailored programs to prepare them for formal education.

03 Over time, we have expanded our initiatives to empower children and youth through skill development and livelihood programs, rehabilitating over 40 disabled children, and equipping them with the tools to lead independent and dignified lives.

04 To address the critical need for safe and nurturing environments, we have established residential care homes in three locations across Bangalore:

- Dr. Raju Boys Home (2022): Providing care and support to 25 boys.
- Samartha Girls Home (2023): A supporting for 20 girls.
- Bandavya Boys Home (2023): Supporting 10 children with essential care and resources.

05 Recognizing the transformative power of technology, we launched an online education initiative in partnership with eVidyaloka in 2020, reaching 12 government schools and benefiting over 1,200 students through virtual classes.

Our journey of growth has been fueled by an ever-expanding network of partners, including government bodies, educational institutions, corporate sponsors, and NGOs, as well as a dedicated team of volunteers. Together, we have significantly broadened our reach, transforming lives and creating a lasting impact across communities.

OUR CURRENT PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES

Since 2019, Samartha Trust has been dedicated to improving the lives of vulnerable children and marginalized communities. Our current programs and activities include:

SCHOOL READINESS CENTER FOR CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES

The program offers a comprehensive support, particularly focusing on those facing challenging circumstances requiring additional attention. Our program is dedicated to fostering a joyful childhood for these children. To instill positive attitudes and confidence at an early age, we conduct a 'Child to Child' program that includes Personality Development sessions, Summer camps, and Adventure camps. Our program caters to children with Cerebral palsy, Intellectual disability, Autism, and ADHD (Attention Deficient Hyperactive Disorder). These activities take place at our School Readiness Center, where children learn Daily Living Skills, receive therapeutic support, and are introduced to basic concepts in Language, Mathematics, and Communication. Currently, we support 45 children (24 boys and 21 girls) with disabilities through our 'School Readiness Program' in South Bangalore, providing essential education to the Anjanappa Garden community.

DR. RAJU'S BOYS HOME

Dr. Raju Boys Home is a residential facility for underprivileged boys, including street children, runaways, and orphans. Located in the Vijayanagar Public School Premises, Chandra Layout, Bangalore, the home currently accommodates 25 boys. It provides them with shelter, care, and education in English medium.

SAMARTHA GIRLS HOME

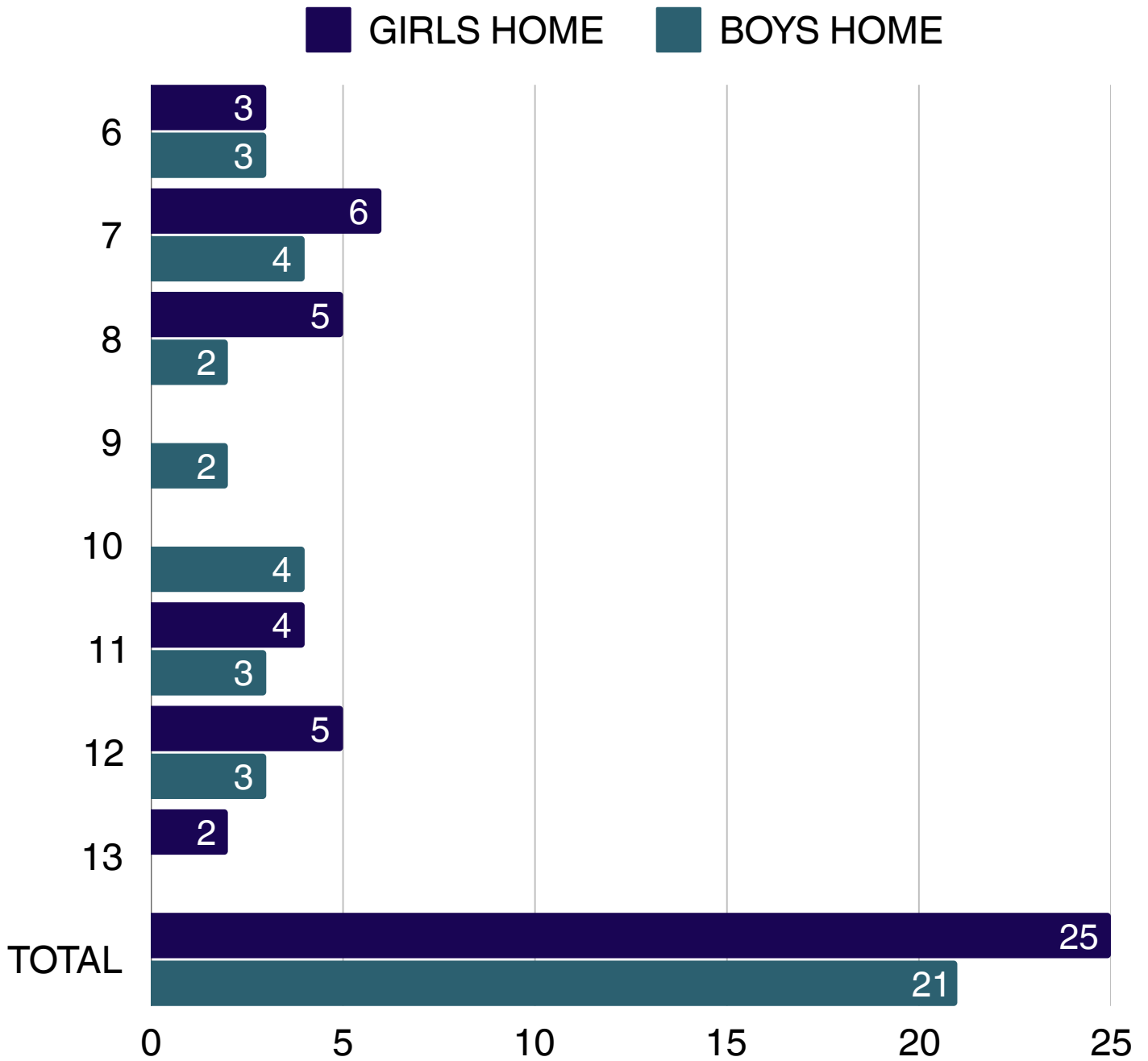
Following the success of Dr. Raju Boys Hostel, Samartha Trust initiated a similar setup for girls living on the streets and in challenging circumstances. With the support of Mr. Ramalinga Reddy, Minister of Transport, Mr. Mohan, and the school management, Samartha Girls Home was established on July 27, 2023. Identifying girls in dire need of support for their growth and development, we enrolled 25 children into Samartha Girls Home. These home offered stability, emotional support, and access to education and healthcare, which are often lacking in their previous circumstances. The home created a positive impact on their physical, emotional, and cognitive development, helping them grow into confident and independent individuals.

ISSUES OF CHILDREN ADMITTED TO SAMARTHA TRUST

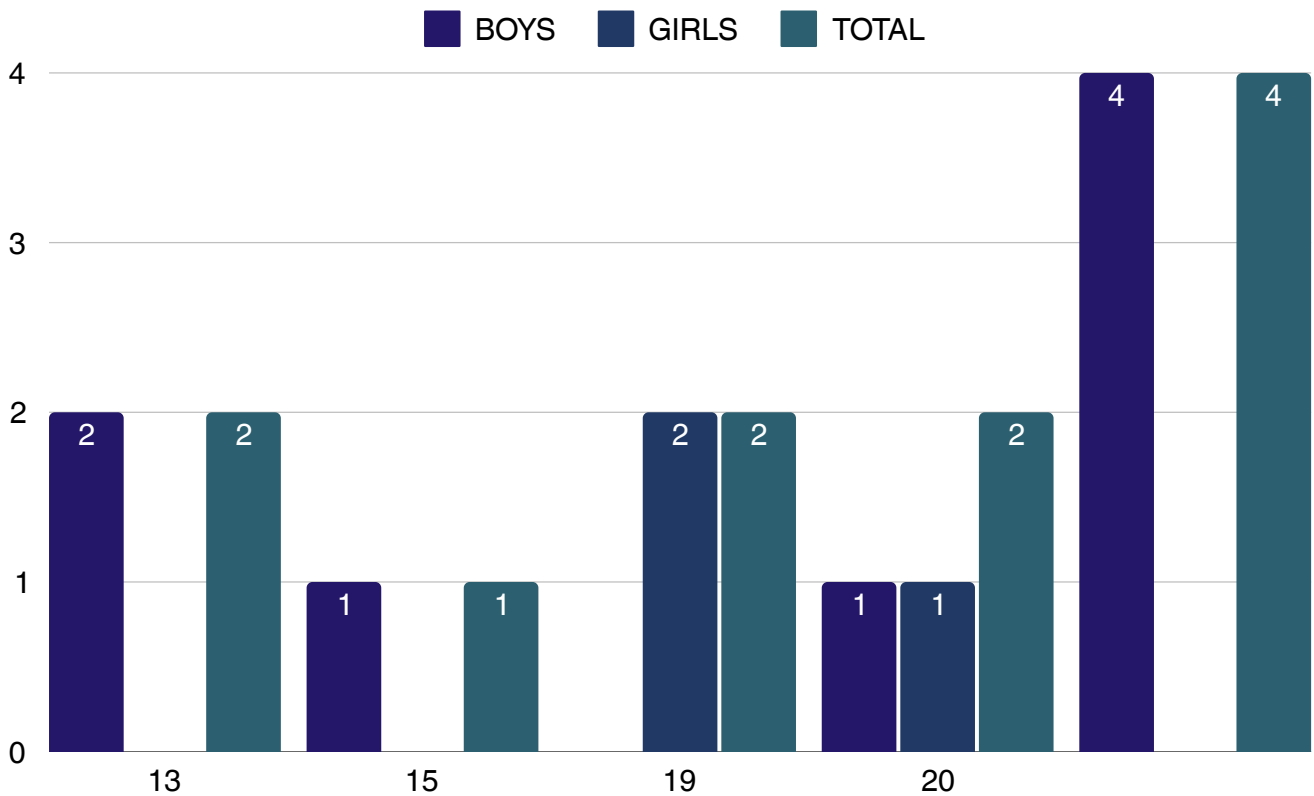
Since 2019, Samartha Trust has been dedicated to improving the lives of disabled people, vulnerable children and marginalized communities. Children admitted to Samartha Trust are vulnerable children, street children, orphans, children with disabilities, and those from families with alcoholic parents, face a range of issues:

- 1 Many children have experienced traumatic events such as abuse, neglect, or abandonment, leading to emotional distress and behavioral issues.
- 2 Children often come from backgrounds where access to education is limited or non-existent, impacting their future prospects and opportunities and health issues due to neglect, malnutrition, and lack of access to proper healthcare services.
- 3 Children often come from impoverished backgrounds, with limited access to basic necessities such as food, shelter, and clothing.
- 4 Children with alcoholic parents who are neglected, abused, and instability at home, affect their overall well-being and development.
- 5 Children with disabilities require specialized care, support, and access to resources that may not be available, Samartha Trust provides the support.
- 6 Children from vulnerable backgrounds, such as orphans or street children, may face social stigma and discrimination, impacting their self-esteem and integration into society.

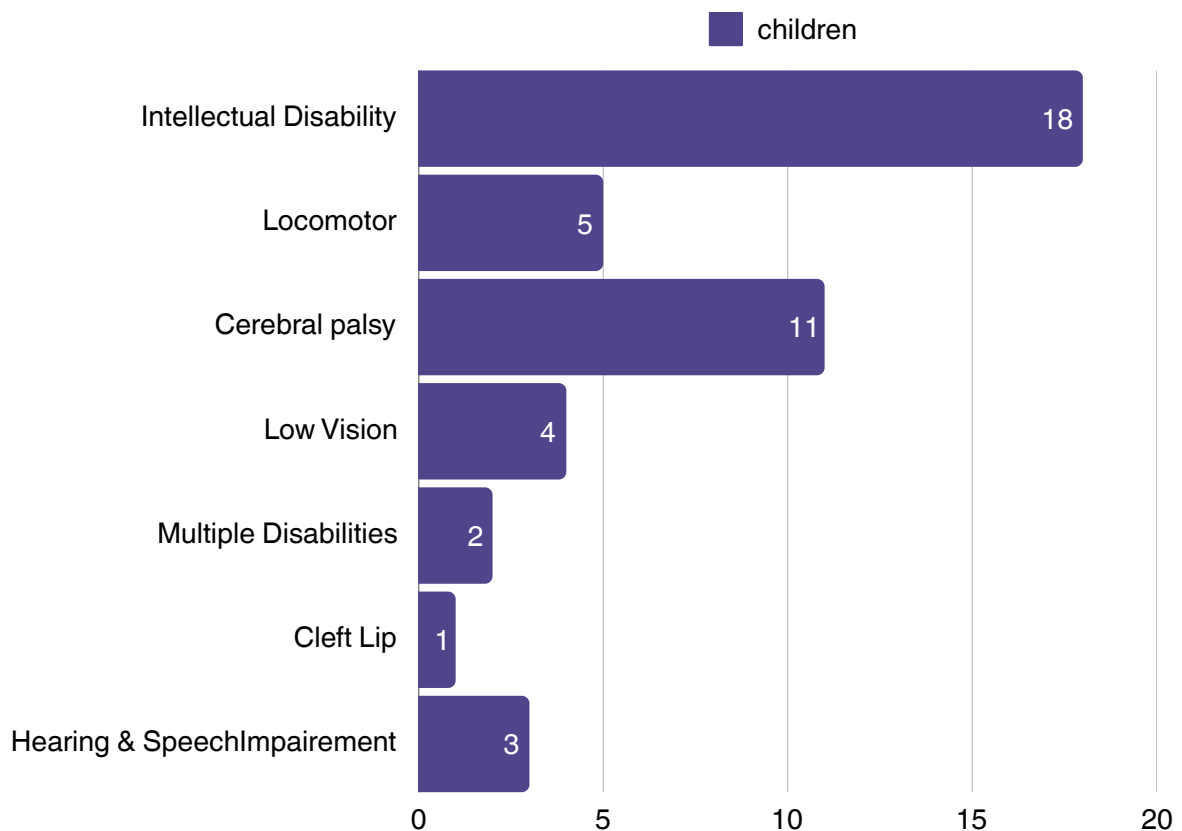
GIRLS AND BOYS UNDER SAMARTHA TRUST

Inauguration of Samartha Girls Home.

In July 2023, Minister Ramalinga Reddy inaugurated the Samartha Girls Home at the Government Higher Primary School in Adugodi, Bangalore. The event showcased cultural performances by the girls, and DSP Mallikarjuna presented them with welcome kits. The Samartha Girls Home provides a secure and nurturing environment for young girls, focusing on safe shelter, education, skill development, vocational training, and emotional well-being. The home aims to build self-confidence, equip the girls with essential life skills, and create a strong sense of belonging, empowering them to aspire to brighter futures.



Bala Vikasa Class

Throughout the academic year, the team conducted the Bala Vikasa Class, offering weekly sessions on value education with themes such as honesty and responsibility. In 2023-2024, the program impacted 46 children, fostering discipline and honesty through interactive storytelling. As a result, participants demonstrated improved behavior and a deeper understanding of core values, equipping them with essential life skills for their future.

Counselling

Throughout the year, the team conducted regular counseling sessions for children at our centers, recognizing the need to address the trauma experienced by those from vulnerable backgrounds. Monthly group counseling sessions were held across all centers, complemented by individual counseling for students requiring focused support. As a result, many children showed improved emotional resilience, better-coping skills, and increased confidence in addressing their challenges, enabling them to focus more effectively on their personal growth and education.



EDUCATION -



Education Empowerment:

Over the past year, Samartha Trust supported 75 children from challenging backgrounds, including street life, orphanhood, dysfunctional families, and disabilities—many of whom face vulnerable and dangerous circumstances. Through our education program, these children engaged in a variety of enriching activities, such as computer classes, monthly assessments, value education, life skills training, spoken English classes, bridge courses, remedial lessons, perspective-building sessions, quizzes, and library activities. This holistic approach has equipped them with essential knowledge and skills, empowering them to build brighter futures.

Empowering Children with Disabilities:

Samartha Trust is dedicated to providing inclusive education, ensuring that every child, regardless of their abilities, has access to quality learning opportunities. Our programs emphasize primary education and focus on activities of daily living (ADLs) to promote independence. The curriculum includes color identification to stimulate cognitive development, creative activities to foster imagination, and exercises to enhance hand-eye coordination, essential for developing motor skills. In addition, we provide counseling to break barriers and promote inclusivity, empowering children to succeed academically and lead fulfilling lives.



Throughout the year, our team at the center implemented a variety of activities, including inclusive education, basic education, ADLs, color identification, and hand-eye coordination exercises. As a result, we observed significant improvements in the overall well-being, confidence, and developmental progress of the children we serve, enabling them to thrive in their daily lives.

Back To School Campaign:

In August 2023, we launched a "Back to School" campaign at the Government Tamil and Kannada Higher Primary School in Cheluvadipalya, Bengaluru, with the aim of re-enrolling children, including those with disabilities, who had dropped out. The initiative focused on promoting inclusive education by addressing barriers to access and providing necessary support. As a result, eight students with disabilities were identified, counseled, and successfully enrolled in foundation classes before they joined the government school, ensuring a smooth transition back to education.

Stimulating Development:

Through our program for children with disabilities, we incorporated activities such as color identification and hand-eye coordination exercises to stimulate cognitive development and enhance motor skills. These interactive experiences fostered creativity, focus, and dexterity, empowering children to explore their environment confidently. As a result, participants demonstrated noticeable improvements in motor coordination, increased engagement, and greater overall developmental progress.

**School Exhibition:**

The exhibition at Vijayanagara Public School successfully showcased students' talent and creativity across various subjects, including science. Students from Samartha Trust presented innovative experiments, models, and artwork, effectively demonstrating their learning. The interactive sessions, where students explained their projects, enhanced their communication skills and boosted their confidence, making the event a resounding success.



Monthly Assessment:

During the academic year 2023–2024, monthly assessments were conducted for children across various subjects to monitor progress and identify areas for improvement. These tests reinforced learning, encouraged consistent study habits, and prepared students for future academic challenges, ensuring a strong educational foundation. As a result of our tailored educational programs, 95% of students showed significant improvement in their academic performance, underscoring the effectiveness and success of our approach.



REMEDIAL CLASSES

The remedial classes conducted during 2023–2024 offered personalized support to 46 students, addressing their specific learning needs and improving their academic skills. These classes focused on strengthening foundational concepts, providing individual attention, and using tailored teaching methods to help students overcome challenges in their studies. As a result, 85% of the students showed marked improvement in their academic performance and confidence. These classes not only enhanced their understanding of key subjects but also fostered a positive attitude toward learning, equipping them with the skills and motivation needed for continued academic success.

PARENTS ENGAGEMENT

During the year, the team conducted regular follow-ups with guardians, parents, and communities by interacting with them monthly once. Child Health Updates included a briefing for parents on their children's health status and suggestions for improvements since the last meeting. This platform facilitated information exchange, addressed concerns, and empowered parents with the knowledge to support their children effectively, strengthening the bond between the center and families for the holistic development of children with disabilities. Additionally, a Mental Health Awareness Program was held in September 2024 at Ambedkar Samudaya Bhavana, Cheluvadipalya, Bangalore, led by mental health expert Mrs. Gracy, covering common conditions, stress management techniques, and strategies to alleviate depression.



ENHANCEMENT COURSES -



BRIDGE COURSE

The Bridge Course program at Samartha Trust welcomed 25 students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds, migrant communities, and marginalized sections of society, underscoring the organization's commitment to inclusive education. The curriculum addressed foundational gaps in key subjects such as mathematics, science, language arts, and social studies. Personalized learning strategies, including individualized attention and peer mentoring, were employed to cater to diverse learning needs. As a result, the students showed remarkable academic progress, with many improving their grades, demonstrating the program's success in bridging learning gaps and enhancing educational outcomes.



ONLINE CLASSES IN GOVT SCHOOL

From 2023 to 2024, the Samartha Trust and eVidyaloka program extended its educational initiatives to four new schools, focusing on students from 5th to 8th standard. This expansion successfully impacted 412 students, significantly shaping their academic journeys. By providing access to quality education through the collaboration of Need Base India and eVidyaloka, the program empowered students with essential knowledge and skills. Over the past year, online education programs in English, mathematics, and science not only improved students' academic performance but also introduced advanced technological tools. Additionally, efforts to enhance school infrastructure further supported a conducive learning environment, demonstrating the program's effectiveness in driving educational progress.

ACTIVITIES AT SAMARTHA TRUST

Dance Classes

Every Saturday and Sunday, Samartha Trust Home organizes dance classes for children, led by professional instructors. These sessions introduce various dance styles, fostering physical fitness, creativity, and self-expression while instilling teamwork and discipline. As a result, children have shown improved physical coordination, boosted confidence, and a stronger sense of collaboration. The classes provide a fun and healthy way to channel their energy and enthusiasm, contributing to their overall development.



Spoken English:

Every Saturday and Sunday, the U & I Organization conducts English classes for children at Samartha Trust Home, focusing on reading, writing, speaking, and comprehension skills. Through interactive methods such as storytelling and educational games, the curriculum is customized to suit each child's proficiency level. Small class sizes ensure personalized attention, fostering a supportive learning environment. As a result, children have demonstrated significant improvements in their language abilities, boosted confidence in communication, and enhanced academic performance. U & I's dedication to education equips these children with critical skills for future personal and professional success.

Walkathon Rally Participation

On August 20, 2024, GM Hospitals organized an inclusive Walkathon Rally to raise awareness and support for disabled children, with enthusiastic participation from Samartha Trust. The event celebrated inclusivity by bringing together participants with and without disabilities, fostering unity and understanding. The disabled children from Samartha Trust demonstrated exceptional resilience and enthusiasm, inspiring others with their determination. As a result, the rally successfully promoted community engagement, strengthened a sense of belonging and acceptance, and reinforced the message that everyone deserves equal opportunities and recognition, regardless of their abilities.



FOSTERING SOCIALIZATION: EMPOWERING CHILDREN THROUGH SOCIAL INTERACTION

EDUCATIONAL TRIP

In February 2024, we organized a two-day educational excursion for children, with 76 participants. We arrived in Sagara at 7 a.m. and began the day with a refresher for the children. Children explored several notable tourist attractions, including Ikkeri, Aghoreshwara Temple, and Basaveshwara Temple. In the afternoon, the children visited the Varadha Pura Sadhguru Bhagavan Shridhara Swamy Temple, Murudeshwara, Singandur, and Jog Falls, among other locations. The trip was both educational and enriching, providing the children with memorable experiences and a deeper understanding of the local culture and heritage.



SUMMER CAMP

Samartha Trust emphasizes the importance of balancing work and play in children's lives, recognizing the value of formal education and creative pursuits for their overall well-being. In April and May each year, Samartha Homes organizes a 20-day summer camp designed to instill positive values, promote a healthy lifestyle, and reinforce the importance of education.

In 2023, the camp successfully boosted the self-esteem and confidence of 46 children through a variety of engaging activities, including drawing, singing, dancing, reading, debates, quizzes, and sports competitions. Weekend art and craft classes further nurtured their creativity. The program's outcome was evident in the children's enhanced skills, increased confidence, and greater enthusiasm for learning and self-expression.



NUTRITION, HEALTHCARE & HYGIENE SUPPORT



Samartha Trust prioritizes children's well-being by providing four nutritious meals daily, ensuring a balanced diet. Weekly, the children enjoy eggs, non-vegetarian options, sprouts, and fruits, with fruit salads served twice a month. A rotating weekly menu maintains variety, and additional nutritional support is given to underweight children. Clean drinking water is ensured through RO purifiers. To promote health and hygiene, trained medical professionals conduct awareness sessions twice a year, educating children on essential practices. Quarterly health camps, covering eye, ENT, and dental check-ups, are organized both in-house and at private hospitals. All 46 children receive deworming medication twice a year, and their growth and BMI are closely monitored every quarter.

Outcome:

These initiatives have significantly improved the children's overall health and nutritional status. Regular health monitoring and awareness sessions have fostered better hygiene habits, while targeted nutritional interventions have contributed to steady growth and development.

HEALTH CHECKUP AND TEETH CHECKUP FOR STUDENTS

In January, Dr. Asif Ali and his team conducted a comprehensive health checkup at Samartha Trust Home, with a special focus on dental health. The healthcare professionals assessed the children's overall well-being and performed detailed teeth checkups.

Outcome:

This initiative successfully identified early health concerns and provided timely interventions for the children. It also reinforced the importance of good oral hygiene practices. As a result, the children showed improved awareness of personal health and oral care, contributing to their overall well-being.



GENERAL HEALTH

On March 16, 2024, all students from Samartha Trust Home participated in a comprehensive health checkup at Bapujinagar Government Hospital PHC, focusing on their overall well-being and preventive care. Later, on March 30, 2024, Dr. Shruthi conducted a detailed health examination of the 25 children at Samartha Trust Home. Her assessment revealed that all children were in excellent health, energetic, and thriving.



Outcome: These health checkups ensured that the children's physical well-being was closely monitored, enabling timely preventive care. The positive health report demonstrated the effectiveness of the trust's efforts in maintaining the children's overall health and vitality.

MEDICINE DISTRIBUTION

Throughout the year, we organized 12 medicine distributions, held during the first week of each month, to provide essential medications to 15 children who require regular treatment for conditions like epilepsy and other health needs.

Outcome: This initiative ensured that the children received their necessary medications on time, contributing to their continued health and well-being. It helped maintain consistent care for those with chronic health conditions, supporting their overall stability and quality of life.



REHABILITATION FOR DISABLED CHILDREN

At Samartha Trust, we are dedicated to providing holistic care for children with disabilities, focusing on enhancing their physical well-being and quality of life. Our physiotherapy program supports 45 children annually, offering them essential services for improvement in mobility, strength, and independence.

Needs Assessment and Outcomes:

Each child's unique needs and developmental challenges are assessed quarterly. Experienced physiotherapists conduct in-depth evaluations, creating personalized treatment plans. In the recent assessment, 16 children with developmental challenges benefitted from daily exercise and meditation sessions, resulting in improved physical coordination and emotional well-being.

Ongoing Physiotherapy Support and Results:

Throughout the year, physiotherapy classes were held for all 45 children, aiming to help them regain normal movement and functionality. The program began with detailed evaluations and diagnoses, followed by patient education and skill-building for greater independence. Emphasis was placed on stretching and muscle-strengthening exercises, leading to quicker recovery and enhanced physical capabilities.



PHYSIOTHERAPY:

Samartha Trust offers a variety of exercises to address different aspects of rehabilitation, including:

- **Strengthening Exercises:** Focused on building muscle strength, leading to better posture and enhanced endurance.
- **Balancing Exercises:** Aimed at improving stability, resulting in reduced falls and enhanced mobility.
- **Stretching Exercises:** Designed to increase flexibility, allowing for smoother movement.
- **Mobility Exercises:** Promoting greater movement and functional abilities, helping children become more independent in daily tasks.

Overall, the physiotherapy support at Samartha Trust has resulted in noticeable improvements in the children's physical abilities, confidence, and overall quality of life.



COLLABORATIVE CARE APPROACH

We actively involve physiotherapists, teachers, and parents in the assessment process, creating a well-rounded understanding of each child's unique needs. Through collaborative discussions, we develop personalized plans that address individual challenges. This inclusive approach leads to comprehensive and effective care, ensuring the children's overall well-being and growth.

As a result, children engage in a variety of guided exercises, stretching routines, and interactive games designed to support their physical development and motor skills. By emphasizing regular exercise and encouraging active participation, we foster a sense of empowerment and achievement, which enhances both their confidence and physical abilities.



BROADRIDGE COMPANY'S EMPLOYEES VISIT

During this event, employees from Broadridge Company connected with the children of Samartha Trust, fostering strong bonds. The visit was split into two groups: one led creative activities like drawing and painting, encouraging self-expression and showcasing the children's talents. The other organized fun games such as passing the ball and bucket basketball, adding excitement. The children also enthusiastically participated in a dance program. The visit brought joy and positivity, leaving a lasting impact on the community and the children.



EXPOSURE FOR STUDENTS

On May 3rd, Hostel Manager Manju and Madhu organized a visit to Amazon for the students. Amazon employees shared their experiences and career advice, inspiring the students. The day concluded with a fun outing to Orion Mall, blending learning with enjoyment. On May 11th, students from Samartha Girls' Home participated in another educational visit to Amazon. This excursion provided valuable insights into the workplace environment and various career opportunities, helping to shape their future aspirations.

WHEELCHAIR DISTRIBUTION ON 27/01/2024

On January 27, Samartha Trust distributed wheelchairs to physically disabled students of the organization. The hostel students organized a heartwarming dance performance to lift their spirits, creating a joyful atmosphere. Everyone shared a meal, fostering a sense of camaraderie and support for those in need. The event was a beautiful display of compassion and solidarity, emphasizing the importance of empathy and inclusivity within the community.



SAMARTHA TRUST'S SAMARTHA AHAARA SEVA DONATION

On May 30th, Samartha Trust's Samartha Aahaara Seva donated heartfelt to the Kidwai Cancer Institute. They provided bread, jam, fruits, and water bottles for the cancer patients and generously donated a wheelchair to one patient. This act of kindness and support significantly impacted the lives of those in need.



BLANKET DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM:

On December 4, 2023, we organized a Blanket Distribution Program in Budgam district, Jammu and Kashmir, to support those in need during the harsh winter.
